ENTRANCE COUNSELING STEPS

If you are a first-time borrower at LSB, you will need to complete entrance counseling.

You can complete online entrance counseling using the FSA ID obtained from the U.S. Department of Education. (Your FSA ID is the same username and password you used to complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online.

EXIT COUNSELING STEPS

Federal Direct Loan student borrowers are required to complete an Exit Counseling session upon graduation, withdrawing from the institution or when the student drops below Half-time status for any term. This Exit Counseling session makes sure the student understands rights and responsibilities as a federal student loan borrower. The institution allows the borrower to complete online exit counseling using the FSA ID obtained from the U.S. Department of Education. (Your FSA ID is the same username and password you used to complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online.
